An address along the fashionable *Saint Germain des Près*? Swoon worthy.

Sadly, years of neglect took their toll on this gracious (5,000 square feet) Parisian apartment. Enter designer Elodie Sire from d.mesure and *voilà*— a French beauty is revived.



A carefree mix of flea market finds and contemporary furniture anchors the light filled living room which overlooks the terrace. Original ceilings, painted white, amplify available light and play up the newly installed Marie Antoinette floors in grey. Large scale artworks and a blue velvet Boà Sofa designed by Fernando & Humberto Campana are dominant features in the room.







The vintage foosball table strikes a playful pose near the dining room, which is turned out in more flea market finds. The black Jitz table sports a mass of white candles for evening meals.
